Note : (1) R.O.C. And Singapore: The average yearly working hours in this table are calculated by the MOL with the following formula: Average yearly working hours = Average monthly working hours × 12 = Average weekly working hours × 52.

(2) Singapore: Before 2005, data pertain to private sector establishments each with at least 25 employees. From 2006 onwards, data also include the public sector.

(3) R.O.C.: 1.Exclude Agriculture, Forestry, Fishing and Animal Husbandry. 2. Employees.

(4) Korea: Data for total employment taken from the OECD National Accounts questionnaire reply.

(5) Japan: Data for total employment are Secretariat estimates based on data on monthly hours worked by regular workers in the non-farm private sector taken from the Monthly Labour Survey of Establishments.

(6) Because average annual hours are affected by the employment type and structure and R.O.C. part time person rate are lower than other countries, the average annual hours in R.O.C. are relative high.

(7) Part time person is defined as the usual weekly hours is not more than 30 hours, only in Singapore is defined as the usual weekly hours is not more than 30 hours.
